Things to Know

- **Dicky Pride** captured the 2026 DICK'S Open for his second PGA TOUR Champions title after defeating World Golf Hall of Fame member and three-time tournament champion **Pádraig Harrington** with a par on the first playoff hole at En-Joie Golf Course.

Dicky Pride, 63-70-65 – 198 (-18)

- 56-year-old secures his second career win on PGA TOUR Champions in his 136th career start; first title since the 2021 Mitsubishi Electric Classic.
 - Ends a winless drought of 5 years, 1 month and 12 days (or 1869 days)
- Wins in his sixth appearance at the DICK'S Open, improving on a previous-best 4th-place finish (2023); has played the event each of the last six editions.
- Converts a first-round lead/co-lead into victory for the first time on PGA TOUR Champions; was 0-for-3 when leading or co-leading after 18 holes.
- Improves from No. 29 to No. 13 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings with the victory.
- Opening 63 tied the lowest first round in DICK'S Open history, matching Joe Ozaki (2008) and Steve Allan (2025).
- Lone PGA TOUR win came at the 1994 Federal Express St. Jude Classic.

Other Notes

- 36-hole leader **Pádraig Harrington** finished runner-up with a final-round 6-under 66 to tie Pride with 18-under 198, forcing a playoff; the World Golf Hall of Fame member came up one stroke short in seeking his fourth DICK'S Open title (2022, 2023 and 2024; did not compete in 2025) and 12th victory on PGA TOUR Champions.
- In his PGA TOUR Champions debut after turning 50 on June 15, **Michael Block** finished T9 at 13-under after a closing 67; the PGA of America club professional at Arroyo Trabuco G.C. in Mission Viejo, California stood at 16-under playing the 54th and final hole before a triple-bogey 7 at the par-4 18th. Block closed 66-70-67.
 - Finished T15 at the 2023 PGA Championship; has competed in 10 major championships, including the PGA Championship each of the last five years.
- **Matt Gogel** (3rd) closed with 65 to finish at 17-under and earned his second career 3rd place finish and first of the 2026 season.
 - Previous best career-finish: T3 (2025 Constellation FURYK & FRIENDS)
