Things to Know

- World Golf Hall of Fame member **Pádraig Harrington** posted a 5-under 67 and enters the final round with a one-shot lead, with the chance to secure his fourth DICK'S Open title in his fourth appearance.

Pádraig Harrington, 65-67 – 132 (-12)

- The 54-year-old seeks his 12th PGA TOUR Champions title and first win this season (72nd career start).
 - Last win: 2025 ISPS HANDA Senior Open
 - With a win, would mark his fifth-consecutive year with at least one victory (2022, 2023, 2024, 2025).
- Looks to secure his fourth career win at the DICK'S Open (2022, 2023, 2024; did not compete in 2025).
 - Would become the fifth player (eighth instance overall) to win a Champions Tour event at least four times, and the first since Steve Stricker in 2024 (Sanford International).
- Records his tournament-low 36-hole score (132) in his fourth appearance.
 - Previous low 36-hole score: 133 (2022, 2024).
- Marks his eighth time leading/co-leading entering the final round of a 54-hole event on PGA TOUR Champions; has converted 5-of-7 into victories.
- Entered the week ranked No. 17 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings with three top-10s in six starts, including a season-best T2 at the Cologuard Classic, where he lost to Steven Alker in a playoff.
- Has notched four of his 11 wins on PGA TOUR Champions in late June: 2022 U.S. Senior Open (June 26), 2023 DICK'S Open (June 25), 2024 DICK'S Open (June 23), 2025 U.S. Senior Open (June 29).

Other Notes

- First-round leader **Dicky Pride** (T2) sits one-stroke back from the lead (-11) in his sixth DICK'S Open appearance (best finish: 4th, 2023); seeks his second win on PGA TOUR Champions.
 - Lone victory: 2021 Mitsubishi Electric Classic
- **Thongchai Jaidee** (T2) posted a 67 and enters the final round at 11-under; the 56-year-old seeks his third win on PGA TOUR Champions (last win: 2023 PURE Insurance Championship).
- **John Daly** (T13) carded the low round of the day for a Champions Tour career-best 9-under 63 and enters Sunday at 8-under. The 60-year-old seeks his second win on PGA TOUR Champions (158th start), and his second title at En-Joie Golf Club in Endicott, NY, site of the former B.C. Open, where he captured his second-of-five PGA TOUR titles (1992).
 - Last PGA TOUR Champions win: 2017 Insuperity Invitational
- Making his PGA TOUR Champions debut after turning 50 on June 15, **Michael Block** sits 8-under 136 (T13); seeks to become the 23rd player in Champions Tour history to win in his debut, and the second this season (Zach Johnson, James Hardie Pro Football Hall of Fame Invitational); at the age of 50 years and 13 days, would

become the fifth-youngest winner in Champions Tour history with a victory on Sunday; PGA of America club professional at Arroyo Trabuco G.C. in Mission Viejo, California, finished T15 at the 2023 PGA Championship; has competed in 10 major championships, including the PGA Championship each of the last five years.
