### Things to Know

- **Boo Weekley** carded bogey-free 66 for the second consecutive day and takes a one-stroke lead over World Golf Hall of Fame member **Ernie Els** into the final round of the Insperity Invitational presented by UnitedHealthcare.

### Boo Weekley, 66-66 – 132 (-12)

- The 52-year-old seeks his first win on PGA TOUR Champions (64th start).
  - Best finish: T2 (2026 Chubb Classic)
- Entered the week ranked No. 19 in the 2026 Charles Schwab Cup standings with two top-10 finishes (eight starts).
  - Top-10 finishes in 2026: T2 (Chubb Classic), 9th (James Hardie Pro Football Hall of Fame Invitational)
- Matched his low 18-hole score of the 2026 season (23rd stroke-play round).
  - Previous instance: 66 (Insperity Invitational, 1st Round)
- This is his second-lowest 36-hole score on PGA TOUR Champions (132).
  - Lowest: 128 (2024 Rogers Charity Classic) – finished T10
- Is the lone player in the field without a bogey or worse after 36 holes.
- This is his first time leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions.
  - Previous best 36-hole position: 2nd (2025 DICK'S Open) – finished T3; T2 (2024 Rogers Charity Classic) – finished T10
- Looks to become the second first-time winner of the 2026 season on PGA TOUR Champions.
  - Previous instance: Zach Johnson (2026 James Hardie Pro Football Hall of Fame Invitational)
- Will play in the last group of the final round for the first time this season.
- Making his third appearance at the Insperity Invitational, he has finished T69 (2024) and T22 (2025).
- One of his three wins on the PGA TOUR came in the state of Texas (2013 Charles Schwab Challenge).

### Other Notes

- World Golf Hall of Fame member **Ernie Els** (2nd) matched the low round of the day (66) and enters Sunday at 11-under. The 56-year-old seeks his eighth win on PGA TOUR Champions (136th start).
  - Last win: 2025 Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai
  - Best finish of 2026: T2 (Hoag Classic)
- 66-year-old **Tom Pernice Jr.** (T3) carded 66 to shoot his age or better for the first time on PGA TOUR Champions. He seeks his seventh win on the Champions Tour (347th start).
  - Last win: 2019 Bass Pro Shops Legends of Golf at Big Cedar Lodge (team event with Scott Hoch)

- **Charlie Wi** (T3) posted 68 and enters the final round at 9-under. The 54-year-old seeks his first win on PGA TOUR Champions (78th start).
  - Best finish: 2nd (2023 Invited Celebrity Classic); T2 (2023 TimberTech Championship)
- Seven players are T5 at 8-under: World Golf Hall of Fame member **Padraig Harrington**, 17-time PGA TOUR Champions winner **Miguel Angel Jiménez**, defending champion and Charles Schwab Cup leader **Stewart Cink**, rookie and two-time major champion **Zach Johnson**, 2025 PGA TOUR Champions Rookie of the Year **Tommy Gainey**, two-time Insperity Invitational champion (2022, 2023) **Steven Alker** and 18-hole leader **Ben Crane**.
- **Kirk Triplett** withdrew following the second round.
