Today – A cold front to the north will slowly sag southward through the state as we go through the rest of the day. Scattered showers and thunderstorms will be likely, especially between 2pm-6pm this afternoon. Storms could be strong with gusty winds and will produce very heavy rainfall in a short period of time. Showers and storms should dissipate this evening as we lose the heating of the day.
