Things to Know

- Trailing by three points in Modified Stableford entering the final round, World Golf Hall of Fame member **Retief Goosen** scored 14 points on Sunday to win the Mitsubishi Electric Classic presented by Vensure.
- The Mitsubishi Electric Classic was played under the Modified Stableford scoring format.
 - Albatross: 8 points
 - Eagle: 5 points
 - Birdie: 2 points
 - Par: 0 points
 - Bogey: -1 point
 - Double bogey or more: -3 points

Retief Goosen (+39)

- The 57-year-old earned his fifth win on PGA TOUR Champions (150 starts).
 - Wins (5): 2019 Kaulig Companies Championship, 2022 Hoag Classic, 2024 Galleri Classic, 2025 Sanford International, 2026 Mitsubishi Electric Classic
- Earned his first win of the 2026 season (six starts).
 - Previous best finish: 3rd (Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai)
 - Moves up to No. 3 in the 2026 Charles Schwab Cup standings after starting the week No. 9.
- Earned his first win at the Mitsubishi Electric Classic (seven appearances).
 - Previous best finish: T6 (2024)
- Becomes the second player to win at TPC Sugarloaf on both the PGA TOUR and PGA TOUR Champions.
 - Previous instance: Scott McCarron (1997, 2001 BellSouth Classic; 2019 Mitsubishi Electric Classic)
 - Goosen won the 2002 BellSouth Classic
- Becomes the first player to win a Modified Stableford event on both the PGA TOUR and PGA TOUR Champions.
 - Won the 2005 INTERNATIONAL (PGA TOUR)
- This is the 49th win by a player from South Africa on PGA TOUR Champions.
 - Wins by player: Gary Player (22), Ernie Els (7), David Frost (6), Retief Goosen (5), John Bland (5), Hugh Baiocchi (3), Bob Verwey (1)

Other Notes

- Three-time champion (2017, 2023, 2024) **Stephen Ames** (+37) matched the most points scored on Sunday (+19) to take runner-up honors. He scored the most points in Saturday's second round (+16) after opening with two points on Friday to sit T53 after the first round. This is his fifth top-2 finish at the Mitsubishi Electric Classic.
- 18- and 36-hole leader **Zach Johnson** (+36), who was a two-time winner of the BellSouth Classic at TPC Sugarloaf (2004, 2007), scored eight points in the final round en route to finishing 3rd. Johnson has finished in the

top 8 in each of his five starts on PGA TOUR Champions since turning 50 years old on February 24. He remains No. 2 in the 2026 Charles Schwab Cup standings.

- In his bid to win his third consecutive start, tournament host and Charles Schwab Cup leader **Stewart Cink** (+35) matched the most points scored on Sunday (+19) and finished 4th. In his last eight starts on PGA TOUR Champions dating back to last season, he has finished (chronologically) 4th-Won-Won-T2-T6-Won-Won-4th. He remains atop the Charles Schwab Cup standings.
- Making his 200th start on PGA TOUR Champions, defending champion **Jerry Kelly** (+26) finished 14th.
