Today – After a sunny start to the morning, party to mostly cloudy skies are expected this afternoon and evening. There is the slightest chance of a brief light shower during the mid-late afternoon. High temperatures reach the low-mid 80s. A gentle breeze develops this afternoon out of the southwest with a few gusts to 10-12 mph possible across exposed/elevated areas of TPC Sugarloaf.

Extended forecast – A weak cold front moves into the area Saturday morning; morning activity is likely confined to just scattered showers with increasing thunderstorm chances starting mid-late afternoon into the evening. Coverage of afternoon thunderstorms looks to be isolated/hit-or-miss in nature. Sunday has trended drier over the last couple of days, with a mostly dry start expected Sunday morning and just a slight chance of a shower or two Sunday afternoon. Each morning this weekend starts off with mostly light and variable winds, with just a slight breeze expected each afternoon. The higher threshold of winds will be most likely across exposed/elevated areas of TPC Sugarloaf.
