- **Course Setup:** Par 72 / 7,119 yards
- **Round 2 Scoring Average:** 70.791
- **Weather:** Mixed skies with afternoon highs near 70. Winds out of the north around 5-10 mph with a few 15mph gusts. Cloudy skies with a few passing light showers morning temperatures in the mid-50s, warming into the mid-60s by the afternoon. Light NE winds around 3-8 mph.

Things to Know

- 52-year-old **Stewart Cink** cards second consecutive round of 7-under 65 to tie the 36-hole tournament scoring record at 14-under 130, giving him a two-stroke lead over 54-year-old **Charlie Wi**, who is seeking his first PGA TOUR Champions victory at the 2026 Regions Tradition presented by Coca-Cola in Birmingham, Alabama.

Stewart Cink, 65-65 – 130 (-14)

- Reigning Charles Schwab Cup champion posts a second consecutive round of 7-under 65 with eight birdies and one bogey; his only two bogeys for the tournament have both come at the par-5 fifth.
- Ties the Regions Tradition presented by Coca-Cola 36-hole tournament scoring record of 130 (Tom Watson, 2003)
- Seven-time PGA TOUR Champions winner seeking his second major title (2026 Senior PGA Championship) and fourth victory of the 2026 season – which would mark his first PGA TOUR Champions season with four-plus wins.
 - Wins in 2026 (three): Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai, Hoag Classic, Senior PGA Championship
 - Wins in 2025 (three): Insperity Invitational, The Ally Challenge, Charles Schwab Cup Championship
 - Wins in 2024 (one): The Ally Challenge
- Marks his third 36-hole lead/co-lead of the 2026 season and 10th career 36-hole lead/co-lead on PGA TOUR Champions; he is 3-for-9 converting to victory (2024 Ally Challenge, 2026 Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai, 2026 Hoag Classic).
- Ties his third-lowest opening 36-hole score in a PGA TOUR Champions event (128/2026 Hoag Classic; 129/2026 Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai; 130/2024 Charles Schwab Cup Championship).
- Shares the low score of the second round with Retief Goosen (65/Round 2), Ken Tanigawa (65/Round 2), in addition to sharing the low round of the tournament with Alex Cejka (65/Round 1).
- Huntsville, Alabama native making his third appearance at the Regions Tradition, with his best finish being T3 in 2024, his tournament debut.
- Stands No. 1 in the 2026 Charles Schwab Cup standings with three wins (Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai, Hoag Classic, Senior PGA Championship) and six top-10s in as many starts.

Other Notes

- **Charlie Wi** (2nd/-12) opens with five straight birdies and cards a 6-under 66; seeks his first PGA TOUR Champions win in his seventh start of the 2026 season (best finish: 4th/ Hoag Classic)
- World Golf Hall of Fame member **Retief Goosen** (T3/-11) seeks his sixth PGA TOUR Champions victory and first senior major title, coming off last week's win at the Mitsubishi Electric Classic; posts his lowest 36-hole score (133) in his seventh appearance at the Regions Tradition (best Regions Tradition finish: T8/2021)
- Two-time PGA TOUR Champions winner **Thongchai Jaidee** (T3/-11) cards a 6-under 66, his lowest score in his fourth appearance at the Regions Tradition (previous: 67/2025/Rd.2); looks to secure his first victory since 2023 (PURE Insurance Championship)
- 18-hole co-leader and 2021 Regions Tradition champion **Alex Cejka** (T3/-11) cards a 5-under 68
