Things to Know

- 52-year-old **Stewart Cink** holds a three-stroke lead at 15-under 201, with 62-year-old World Golf Hall of Fame member **Colin Montgomerie** (2nd/-12) seeking his first PGA TOUR Champions victory since 2019 at the 2026 Regions Tradition presented by Coca-Cola in Birmingham, Alabama.

Stewart Cink, 65-65-71 – 201 (-15)

- Reigning Charles Schwab Cup champion seeks his eighth PGA TOUR Champions victory and second senior major title (2026 Senior PGA Championship).
- Seeks his fourth win of the 2026 season in his seventh start – which would mark his first PGA TOUR Champions season with four-plus wins.
 - Wins in 2026 (three): Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai, Hoag Classic, Senior PGA Championship
 - Wins in 2025 (three): Insperity Invitational, The Ally Challenge, Charles Schwab Cup Championship
 - Wins in 2024 (one): The Ally Challenge
- Carries a three-shot lead into the final round, marking the largest 54-hole lead at the Regions Tradition since 2022 (Steve Stricker/Won) and tying his largest lead entering the final round of a PGA TOUR Champions event (2024 Ally Challenge/Won; 2025 Boeing Classic/2nd).
- This is his ninth time leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions (3-for-8 converting to victory – 2024 Ally Challenge, 2026 Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai, 2026 Hoag Classic).
- Huntsville, Alabama native making his third appearance at the Regions Tradition records his lowest 54-hole score at the event (201).
 - Previous low 54-hole score at Regions Tradition: 205 (2025/finished T12).
- Would become the first player to lead/co-lead after 18, 36, and 54 holes and win the Regions Tradition since 2022 (Steve Stricker).
- Stands No. 1 in the 2026 Charles Schwab Cup standings for the eighth consecutive week off the strength of three wins (Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai, Hoag Classic, Senior PGA Championship).
- Will play in the final group of the final round for the third time this season (2-for-2 converting to victory).
 - Previous instances: Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai (Won) / Hoag Classic (Won)

Other Notes

- With a win, 62-year-old World Golf Hall of Fame member **Colin Montgomerie** (2nd/-12) would become the oldest winner in Regions Tradition history (oldest winner: Bernhard Langer/59 years of age/2017) and would end a winless drought of six years and six months (last win: 2019 Invesco QQQ Championship).
 - Last time playing in the final group of the final round: 2020 SAS Championship (finished runner-up to Ernie Els).
 - Carded the low round of the third round, a 5-under 67, tying his lowest round of the event in his 12th appearance (previous: 2018/Round 3, 2026/Round 1).
- 2024 Regions Tradition champion **Doug Barron** (T3/-10) cards a 3-under 69; seeks his fifth PGA TOUR Champions career win, and has not won the same PGA TOUR Champions event multiple times.
- 11-time PGA TOUR Champions winner **Steven Alker** (T3/-10) seeks his second title of the 2026 season (Cologuard Classic); making his fifth appearance at Regions Tradition, with three previous top-five finishes (4th/2025, 2nd/2024, T3/2022).
