Mike Weir Answer:

It was kind of a frustrating round. I played really well and didn't make a thing. Couldn't buy a putt all day. So, it's nice to end with one. Kept me within earshot a little bit. Felt like if I didn't make that, probably - six is probably too far back. But within five shots, yeah. Have a good one tomorrow and - I played nice. I played, actually, really well today. Drove the ball great. A lot of great iron shots. Just didn't convert many, but a solid day.

Question: Yeah. Steve Alker had tied the course record 61.

Mike Weir Answer:

Yes.

Question: So, you know, the guys are playing pretty well. You expecting to need a really good score tomorrow?

Mike Weir Answer:

If the conditions stay like this, you know, because it's — it's soft and there wasn't much wind. You know, there was a little bit of wind yesterday so made a little bit tougher. But today, not much wind; so scoring was really good today.

Question: Yeah. And how long was your putt?

Mike Weir Answer:

24.

Question: On 18. Oh, yeah. So nice to sink something like that to keep the momentum rolling tomorrow?

Mike Weir Answer:

Yeah. I mean, I didn't make — I made a five-footer on number 11. Outside of that didn't make anything. So, it's nice to see one go in.
