Mostly sunny to partly cloudy skies can be expected with a light breeze averaging 4-8 mph. Skies will likely clear this evening with temperatures cooling back into the upper 60s after sunset.

Extended forecast – Saturday a southwest breeze will pump warmer temperatures northward with highs returning to the low to mid-80s during the afternoon. Clouds will be on the increase with skies becoming cloudy by the evening hours. A low confidence forecast for Sunday as a decaying thunderstorm complex moves into the state from the west bringing the chance for showers. Model guidance has this complex either moving across the northern parts of Michigan or through Central Michigan. Details will need to be worked over the next day and half.
